Deposits Deposits are \$100.00 per session when you register. **May 1st** camp balances are due. After May 1st any refunds will be minus the \$100 deposit. Payment methods are by cheque, money order or credit card.

Discounts **Sibling:** discount of \$15 per day camp session on 2nd, 3rd etc children attending camp
OR Multiple Session: a discount of \$15 per additional day camp session for a camper registered in two or more day camp sessions.

Referral Rebate If your name appears on the ‘**New Camper Family**’ referral section, you will receive a camper \$25 rebate for a new day camper. Rebates are given at the end of the summer. Both your camper and the new camper(s) must attend summer camp to receive rebate(s).

- *There will be no reduction or refund of camp fees for campers arriving late or leaving early in any session for which they are registered, for any campers removed from camp at the choice or request of the camper or camper’s parent/guardian, or for any campers dismissed from the camp for the contravention of camp guidelines or the camp code of conduct for behavior, viewable at www.circclerranch.ca.*
- *I understand that camp is an “unplugged” environment, and my camper will not bring any electronic devices such as iPods, iPads, cell phones, gaming devices or other personal electronic devices to camp.*

Bus Transportation cost is included in your camp fee. Bus stops for this year are similar to previous years: Ryerson Public School, Masonville Public School, Sherwood Forest Mall, Oakridge Centre, Byron Northview Public School, Kilworth Convenience Centre, Oxbury Mall, Wortley Public School, White Oaks P.S., Southwest Optimist Park, Lambeth P.S. (AE Duffield) (Times to be confirmed) Pick up and drop off at the ranch.

PLEASE NOTE: Lunches and snacks are not provided at day camp this year due to new COVID-19 food safety regulations. Pack a lunch that includes a nutritious lunch, (drink), 2 healthy snacks to be eaten throughout the day and a refillable water bottle. Keep in mind that campers are outside and active for most of the day so they may be hungrier than usual. In our ongoing efforts to respect the environment we encourage packing your camper’s food and drinks in clearly labeled, reusable containers. To keep lunches cool during the day we recommend sending lunches in an insulated lunch bag with an ice pack or frozen drink. To insure the safety of campers and staff with life-threatening allergies do not send peanut or other nut or tree nut products.

The Camper Medical Health form will be available by May 1st and will be based on the most up to date health information required.

We will follow guidelines from the Ontario Government, Local Health Unit and Ontario Camping Association as to how summer camp will be required to operate. These guidelines include, but are not limited to camp capacity, COVID-19 screening, sanitizing, distancing measures, and transportation protocols.
